MARINERS ARE REMINDED THAT WHEN NAVIGATING OR MANOEUVRING WITHIN THE ENCLOSED DOCK SYSTEMS OF LIVERPOOL AND BIRKENHEAD THEY SHALL DO SO AT A SAFE SPEED.

MASTERS ARE ADVISED THAT THEY HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY WHEN MANOEUVRING WITHIN THE ENCLOSED DOCK SYSTEMS TO ENSURE THAT THE VESSEL PROCEEDS AT A SPEED THAT WILL NOT, OR IS UNLIKELY TO CAUSE DAMAGE TO OTHER VESSELS, VESSEL MOORINGS, LOCK GATES OR CAISSONS INCLUDING ANY DOCK WALL, BERTH OR ANY OTHER STRUCTURE WITHIN THE ENCLOSED DOCKS.
