NOTICE TO MARINERS No.4 - 2010

USE OF THE UPPER REACH BY PLEASURE CRAFT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that increased use of the Upper Reaches of the Manchester Ship Canal by pleasure craft can be expected during daylight hours between May and September each year.

The Upper Reaches is the area contained between Salford Wharf (8 Pier) and Hunts Bank Manchester, and includes the Manchester Docks Turning Basin, and pleasure craft can now access the area from the Bridgewater Canal via Pomona Lock.

Mariners are advised to exercise care and caution when approaching the Manchester Turning Basin.
