NOTICE TO MARINERS No.6 - 2010

EMERGENCY WARNING BEACONS RUNCORN LAYBY BERTH.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that emergency warning beacons have been established at the upstream and downstream ends of Runcorn Layby Berth.

Each beacon will display three flashing red lights in a vertical line both by day and by night. The display of this signal will be in conjunction with a continuous sound signal located on Runcorn Layby Berth.

These signals will be exhibited in the event of an emergency situation in the Runcorn Layby Berth area.

Persons in charge of vessels should avoid passing through this area on hearing or observing the signals and should pay close attention to advice relayed by the appropriate radio channel.

When Low Flash operations are taking place at Runcorn Layby Berth, the upper light of both beacons will display a flashing red light.
