BURBO BANK WIND FARM-POTENTIAL RADAR INTERFERENCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE FINAL PHASE OF CONSTRUCTION WORK HAS COMMENCED ON THE INSTALLATION OF THE WIND TURBINES ON THE BURBO BANK WIND FARM SITE.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT THE INSTALLATION OF THE WIND TURBINES MAY CAUSE SOME MARINE RADARS TO EXPERIENCE SPURIOUS ECHO INTERFERENCE AND POSSIBLE SHADOWING IN SOME SECTORS.

MASTERS OF VESSELS APPROACHING THE PORT OF LIVERPOOL AND NAVIGATING IN THE QUEENS AND CROSBY SEA CHANNELS SHOULD BE MINDFUL OF THE NEED TO CONSIDER THE EFFECTS OF RADAR INTERFERENCE AND SHOULD NAVIGATE WITH CAUTION AT ALLTIMES.
